In observance of Memorial Day, the church office will be closed on Monday, May 29.

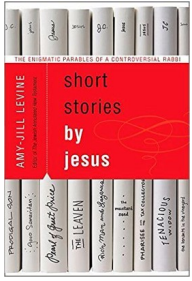
## This July VBS is Hero Central
