Pentecost Offering

On Sunday, May 13 and Sunday, May 20, the Pentecost Special Offering will be collected from our congregation. The information shared here and for the next two weeks is from *What is Pentecost? A Bible Study*, by Jack Wellman. The word Pentecost is from the Greek word "pentekostos" and it's literally a translation of the word "fifty" or "fiftieth" day. Before Jesus' Ascension, He told the disciples to wait in Jerusalem until the Holy Spirit would come. Jesus commanded the disciples to "not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit" (Acts 1:4-5) The church could not even exist without the Holy Spirit and so on the day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit was given to the church and the church was begun.

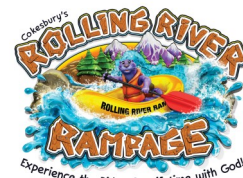
