We will study 1&2 Corinthians. As a basis of our study we will use the study guide from *She Reads Truth*. When the Apostle Paul wrote 1 & 2 Corinthians, the early Church was struggling to grow together as a group of believers. They came from vastly different backgrounds ~ Jewish and Greek, rich and poor, religious and nonreligious ~ and they were learning how to live as one people. In these two letters, Paul challenges the Corinthians to fight for unity and to embrace their identity as one body made of many different parts ~ a challenge still relevant to us today.

Please join us when you can. The group will meet June 25 - August 6. (We will not meet July 16 due to VBS.) Locations will change, but for the first 2 weeks we will meet at Rene's.
