Our goal is to have at least 15 people attend our trip to Lancaster, PA, and the Sight & Sound Theater for the production of “Daniel”! We will stay at the beautiful Hersey Farm Resort in Ronks, PA near the theater (Check-in: 3 pm, Check-out: 11 am).

The Hersey Farm Resort is offering a bundle package that includes:

- a Sight & Sound ticket for a 3:00 pm showing of Daniel
- hotel lodging for 2 nights
- and Breakfast Smorgasbord for November 15 & 16th



For the Bundle ~ Cost per adult:

- Quad Occupancy: \$201.11
- Triple Occupancy: \$229.83
- Double Occupancy: \$287.27
- Single Occupancy: \$492.89

Please note, this pricing depends on whether we meet the 15 person minimum. Also, you should coordinate with whom you would like to room with and indicate that on registration!

What about children? Up to 2 Children (12 years and under) per room: \$37.70 per child (child not included in the occupancy count above)
